

NORTH OLYMPIC DISCOVERY 10K MARATHON INSTRUCTIONS - VIRTUAL RACE COURSE

GREEN SIGNS

North Olympic Discovery Marathon 10K course is all marked and ready for VIRTUAL participants!

Note you do not have to participate on the same course in order to complete the VIRTUAL NORTH OLYMPIC DISCOVERY MARATHON. It is just set up for people who would like to run / walk the actual course.

The Race course is as follows:

*****PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS NOT A CLOSED COURSE. TRAFFIC HAS THE RIGHT OF WAY. ALWAYS LOOK BOTH WAYS FOR TRAFFIC BEFORE CROSSING ANY ROADS ***

The entire course is on the Olympic Discovery Trail (ODT). Although there are portions of the course that share the road with cars. Follow the signs for the Olympic Discovery Trail.

10K START LINE

The 10K Start line is on the corner of Deer Park Loop and Buchanan. Be sure to start heading north along Buchanan Road until you reach the 10K turn around sign on the right hand side (past the ½ marathon turn around almost to the mailbox).





Mile 1:

Once you reach the 10K turn around sign turn around and head back south along Buchanan Dr. Before you get to Deer Park loop Mile marker 1 will be on the left hand side.

Mile 2:

Turn right on the ODT when you get back to Deer Park Loop. Continue west on the ODT. Turn right onto Cedar Park Drive and then turn left onto Scenic View Drive all while staying on the ODT. Turn right to stay on the ODT and head west towards Morse Creek. At the bottom of the hill crossover Strait View Drive and stay on the ODT. Mile marker 2 will be on the right hand side.



Mile 3:

Continue west along the ODT. Mile marker 3 will be on the right hand side.



Mile 4:

Continue west along the ODT. Mile marker 4 will be on the right hand side.



Mile 5:

Continue west along the ODT. Mile marker 5 will be on the right hand side just before Ennis Creek.



Mile 6:

Continue west along the ODT. Mile marker 6 will be on the right hand side.



FINISH LINE:

The finish line is on the right hand side of the ODT just past the yellow bollard in front of the Red Lion Hotel in Port Angeles.
